<p><b>Description</b></p>	<p>Public health researcher H�el�ene Zondag discusses the need for molecular diagnostics to complement serology testing for Treponema pallidum (TP), along with recent data using molecular TP tests in populations with an increased risk of acquiring syphilis. Lead author of the European Mycoplasma genitalium guidelines Dr. Jorgen Skov Jensen discusses the detection and management of M. genitalium and addresses the role of detection of ureaplasmas and M. hominis in patients with STI symptoms.</p>
